
NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT 2010 HOLIDAY AND SUMMER (EXTENDED) PARENTING TIME SCHEDULE¹

A. Summer (Extended) Parenting Time

The non-custodial parent is entitled to one one-half (1/2) of the summer vacation. The time may be either consecutive or split into two (2) segments. The non-custodial parent must give notice to the custodial parent of the selection by April 1, of each year. If such notice is not given, the custodial parent shall make the selection.

If either parent has the children for more than two (2) consecutive weeks, the other parent is entitled to regular parenting time (ie. every other weekend and one (1) night during the week).

B. Special Days

Mother's Day May 7, 2010 – May 9, 2010. With the child's mother from Friday at 6:00 P.M. until Sunday at 6:00 P.M.

Father's Day June 18, 2010 – June 20, 2010. With the child's father from Friday at 6:00 P.M. until Sunday at 6:00 P.M.

Child's Birthday. In even numbered years (i.e. 2010) the non-custodial parent shall have all of the children on each child's birthday from 9:00 A.M. until 9:00 P.M. However, if the birthday falls on a school day, then from 5:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M.

Parent's Birthday. From 9:00 A.M. until 9:00 P.M. with that parent, however, if the parent's birthday falls on a school day, then from 5:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M.

C. Christmas Vacation (based on Huntington County Community School Calendar)

One-half of the period which will begin at 8:00 P.M. on December ____, 2010 and continues to December 30 at 7:00 P.M. If the parents cannot agree on the division of this period, the custodial parent shall have the first half in even-numbered years. In those years when Christmas does not fall in a parent's week, that parent shall have the child from noon to 9:00 P.M. on Christmas Day. The winter vacation period shall apply to pre-school children and shall be determined by the vacation period of the public grade school in the custodial parent's school district.

¹ This schedule applies in all years ending with an even-number.

D. Holidays

New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. (The date of the New Year will determine odd or even year). From December 30th at 7:00 p.m to 7:00 P.M. of the evening before school resumes.

Memorial Day May 28, 2010 – May 31, 2010. From Friday at 6:00 P.M. until Monday at 7:00 P.M.

Labor Day September 3, 2010 – September 6, 2010. From Friday at 6:00 P.M. until Monday at 7:00 P.M.

Thanksgiving November 24, 2010 – November 28, 2010. From 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday until 7:00 P.M. on Sunday.

E. Religious Holidays

Religious based holidays shall be considered by the parties and added to the foregoing holiday schedule when appropriate. The addition of such holidays shall not affect the Christmas vacation parenting time. However, they may affect the Christmas day and Easter parenting time.
